



## BEHAVIORAL FIRST AID

**WHAT:** Behavioral First Aid, a 10-hour course, provides staff with a variety of practical intervention strategies which can be easily implemented in the classroom. Based on the work of Fritz Redl and David Wineman, these techniques are short term in nature and are designed to prevent and address immediate classroom behavioral issues.

Participants learn how factors such as typical behavior patterns, timing, student behavioral motivation, and student perceptions all influence the choice and outcomes of interventions. Through discussion and role plays, staff learn to plan, apply and evaluate "prescriptive interventions".
