



## DEALING WITH THE PASSIVE AGGRESSIVE STUDENT

**WHAT:** Dealing with Passive Aggressive Student, a five-hour course based on the work of Dr. Nicholas Long, provides staff with an understanding of the roots and evolution of passive aggressive behavior and provides strategies for dealing with that behavior.

Unexpressed anger/hostility comes out "sideways". Although not blatantly acting out or aggressive, children who exhibit passive aggressive behaviors can be among the most perplexing and frustrating type of children to work with. Their mild, yet persistent, nudging at the rules has a cumulative effect. Like "water torture", their actions wear away at staff.
