Directions to Newark High School

From West:

Take 490 East to the Pittsford Exit, Rte 31 East Travel on Rte.31 until you reach Newark. Turn right at the 1st traffic light, (Burger King on the corner) go to the stop sign (in Front of Wegman's) turn left onto Miller St. Turn right at the 2nd street off Miller, onto Peirson Ave. Follow Peirson Ave to the traffic light. Turn right at the traffic light into the school driveway. There is a parking lot to your immediate right and also an upper lot accessed at the next right.

From North Near Lake Ontario:

Take 104 East to Route 88(Sodus)- Follow Rte. 88 South all the way to Newark. After crossing the Erie Canal (Quality Inn on your right)- go to the 4th traffic light and turn right onto Maple Ave. Go straight until you reach the 2nd stop sign. Turn left onto Peirson Ave. and then right at the traffic light into the school driveway. There is a parking lot to your immediate right and also an upper lot accessed at the next right.

From East:(Syracuse Area)

Take NYS Thruway west to Exit 42 (Geneva), turn right onto Rte 14 South and take the 1st right onto Rte96 (comes up very quickly). Travel on Rte 96 through Phelps and turn right onto Rte 88. Travel on Rte 88 until the 1st traffic light in Newark. Turn left at that traffic light onto Maple Ave. Go straight until you reach the 2nd stop sign. Turn left onto Peirson Ave. and then right at the traffic light into the school driveway. There is a parking lot to your immediate right and also an upper lot accessed at the next right.

Enter the 2nd door to the right of the main entrance.
Signs will be posted.
