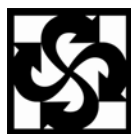
OSHA 10

TRAINING?



- 1.) Provides an employment credential for Worker Safety Training.**
- 2.) Employers prefer to hire individuals with OSHA 10 Certification (Some jobs, i.e., construction industry REQUIRE certification)**
- 3.) Normally, the cost of OSHA Training is between \$300-\$400 (if employers pay for the OSHA 10 Training). This workshop is provided at no cost to eligible youth (up to 21 years old).**
