



## UNDERSTANDING & DEALING WITH CHALLENGING STUDENTS

**WHAT:** Understanding & Dealing With Challenging Students is a 10-hour awareness level course designed to provide all members of the school community a "sampling" of topics to become more aware of the characteristics, needs, and alternative intervention strategies which work with students with social, emotional, and behavioral problems. Although it is an awareness level training, staff are provided with some practical techniques they can begin immediately applying in their school setting. Topics covered include:

- characteristics of students with social/emotional/behavioral problems
- understanding and breaking the conflict cycle
- behavioral first aid
- teaching the skills for success
- coping with physically acting out children
