This program is offered to students through a partnership between Wayne Technical and Career Center, area businesses, and post-secondary institutions. New Vision programs are offered to and designed specifically for high school seniors wishing to engage in a non-traditional, academic-style course that offers the opportunity to explore the career possibilities available in their chosen field of study.

Through the New Vision model of study, you will be given the opportunity to apply principles and theories of your chosen field of learning in a variety of settings through professional collaboration and internships. You will have the opportunity to work directly with professionals in the field, at the actual work site, participating in hands-on procedures. Upon successful completion of these programs, students earn four units of credit towards their NYS high school graduation requirements. Students also have the opportunity to earn college credit through the GEMINI program at FLCC.

If you are interested and are applying for the New Vision Veterinary Assistant program, you must:

- have a high school attendance rate of 90% and above (will be evaluated on an individual basis)
- have taken and passed high school health and have completed (by the end of grade 11) 3 years of Regents English, 3 years of social studies, and 3 years of math
- have passed living environment and have completed (by the end of grade 11) year 3 of science (chemistry preferred)
- have an average of 85 or better in both English and science
- be entering your senior year in September and be on track for graduation in June
- be recommended by your high school counselor (reference form enclosed)
- complete the enclosed application and have your transcript and most recent report card forwarded to Wayne Technical and Career Center
- provide written responses to the items on page 4
- respect the confidentiality necessary for the professional setting
- be able to provide your own transportation to internship sites

Estimated Cost: \$100.

Applications are due Friday, April 2nd 2020 The admissions committee will review each application and a decision regarding enrollment will be made. You and your high school counselor will be notified of this decision.
